



TOOL AND SUPPLY LIST

Communicating with EDGE OUTREACH staff and leadership will give your team a good idea of the specifics your project entails. Depending on the project your group is connected with, it'll be important for your group to bring the necessary tools and supplies necessary. Though being flexible is a critical part of a mission trip, this tool list for construction projects will serve as a guide for individual participants as well as the team as a whole while preparing for your building experience.

EDGE OUTREACH DRESS CODE

For Outdoor Work

- No sleeveless shirts, short shorts or tight-fitting attire.
- No sandals, open-toed shoes or canvas sneakers. Thick-soled shoes ONLY.
- For working at homeless shelters: no shorts, sleeveless shirts, or tight-fitting attire for GIRLS.

ALL PARTICIPANTS TOOL LIST

- Tool box or canvas bag
- Safety goggles
- Ear plugs
- Work gloves
- Hammer (*a GOOD one*)
- Tape measure
- Utility knife
- Carpenter's pencil
- Rag
- Two-pocket nail apron
- Paintbrush
- Water bottle
- Bug repellent
- Sunscreen
- Old, light-colored clothes that can be ruined (*t-shirts — no sleeveless, jeans/pants, socks*)
- Boots or shoes with thick soles (*no loafers/sandals*)
- Hat or ball cap

GROUP TOOL LIST

Painting Supplies

- Paintbrush for everyone! (*2-3 inch*)
- Small buckets to paint from
- Roller kits for every 3 people (*We suggest a 5 gallon bucket with a screen. You can also use paint pans, but they tip easily.*)
- Roller cages
- Roller poles
- Roller covers/naps
- Drop cloths
- Rags (*lots*)
- Caulk guns
- Soap to clean your brushes with
- Wire brushes

Miscellaneous Supplies

- Folding saw horses
- Wrenches
- Ladders, extension and/or step (*depending on the job, 1 for every 6 people*)
- Caulk gun (*1 for every 2 people*)
- Brooms
- Drop cloths
- Flat and round shovels
- Sharpie pen/magic marker
- 5-gallon water containers (*1 per job site*)
- Cooler to haul food supplies (*1 per job site*)

Use colored tape, paint or some other means to put identification markings on all your tools!
